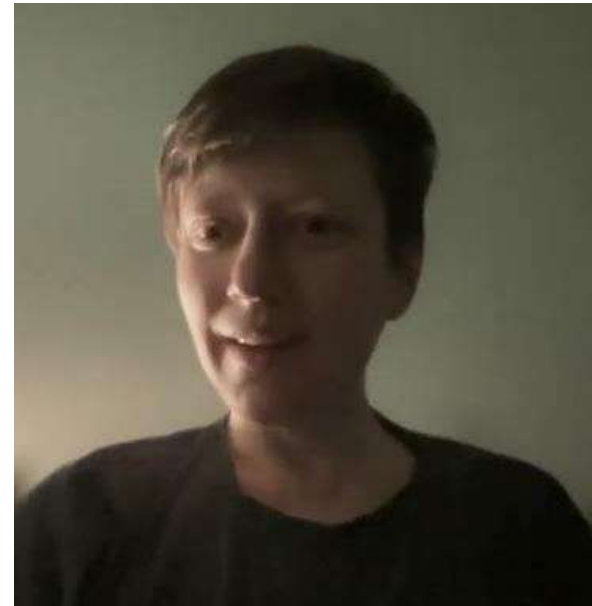

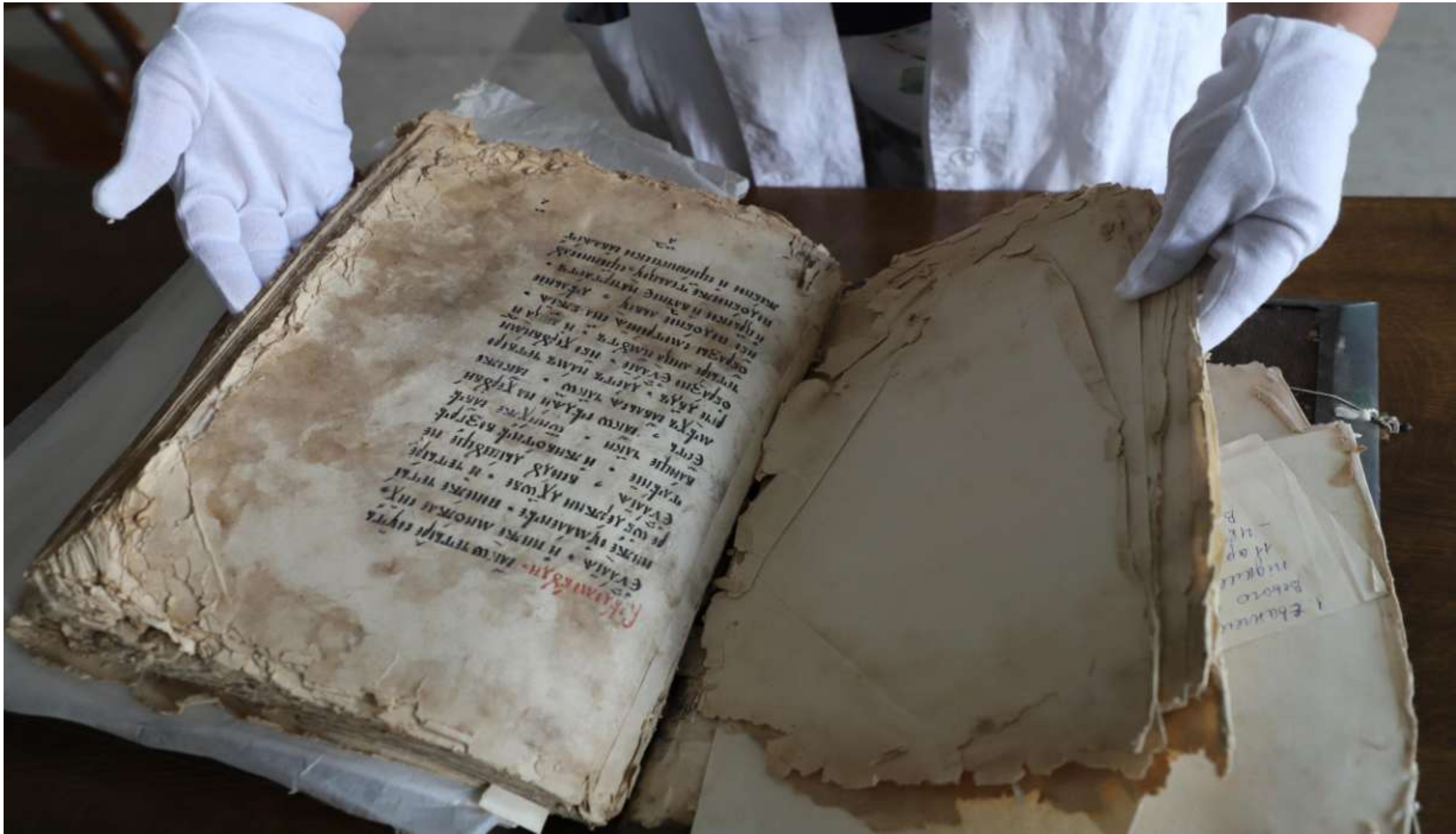

A network of archives, libraries and museums have joined together to save Ukrainian digital records.

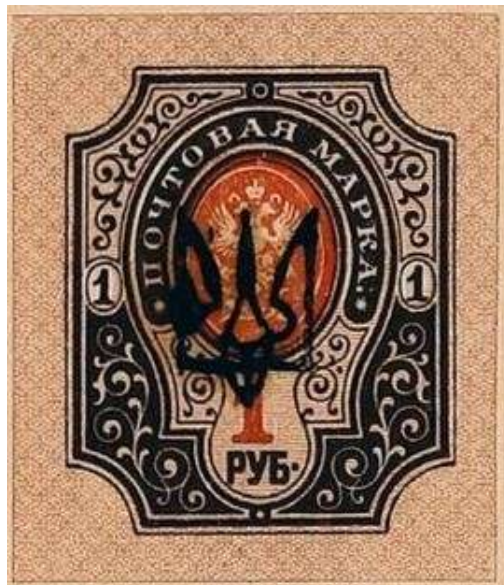
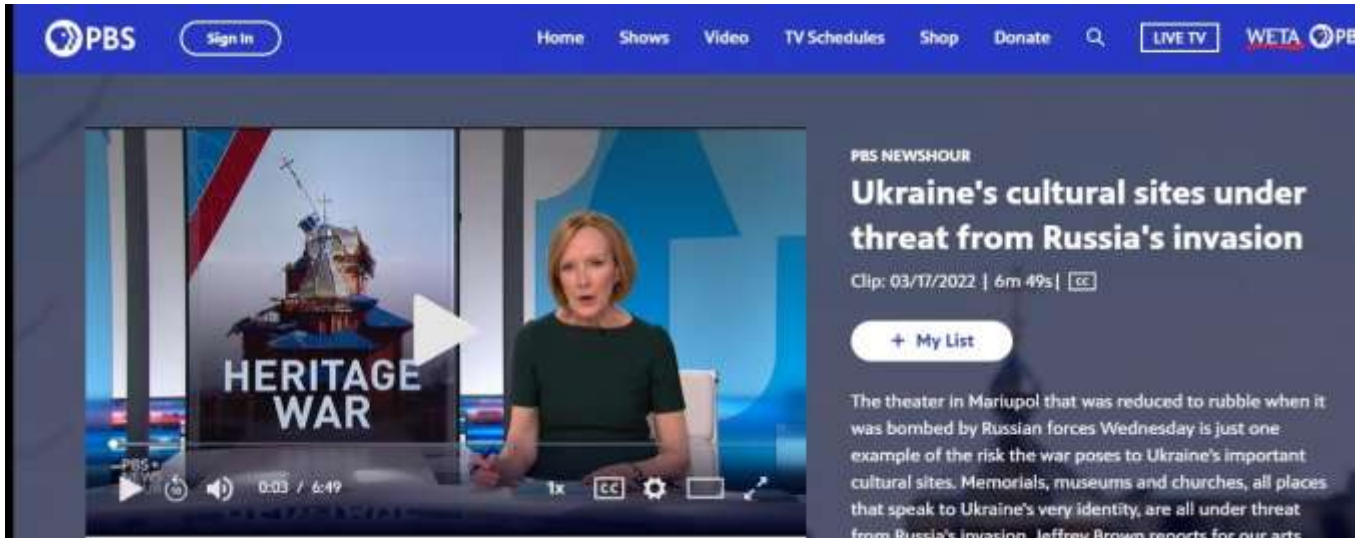
ALIPH has supported a Ukrainian 3-D scanning project for historical architecture in Lviv.
